LIBRARIES

The four branches of York University Libraries are host to more than three million visitors annually. Our libraries provide access to a robust collection of resources, including more than 600,000 e-books, 72,000 full-text e-journals and 2.6 million printed volumes. Students have access to more than 3,600 quiet and collaborative study spaces, as well as research and reference assistance from any one of our 150 librarians and staff members.

With more than 300 student clubs and organizations, the intellectual, cultural and social offerings at York are some of the richest in Canada. Sport & Recreation has diverse programming, including intramurals, a fitness centre, sports clubs, instructional classes and more.
